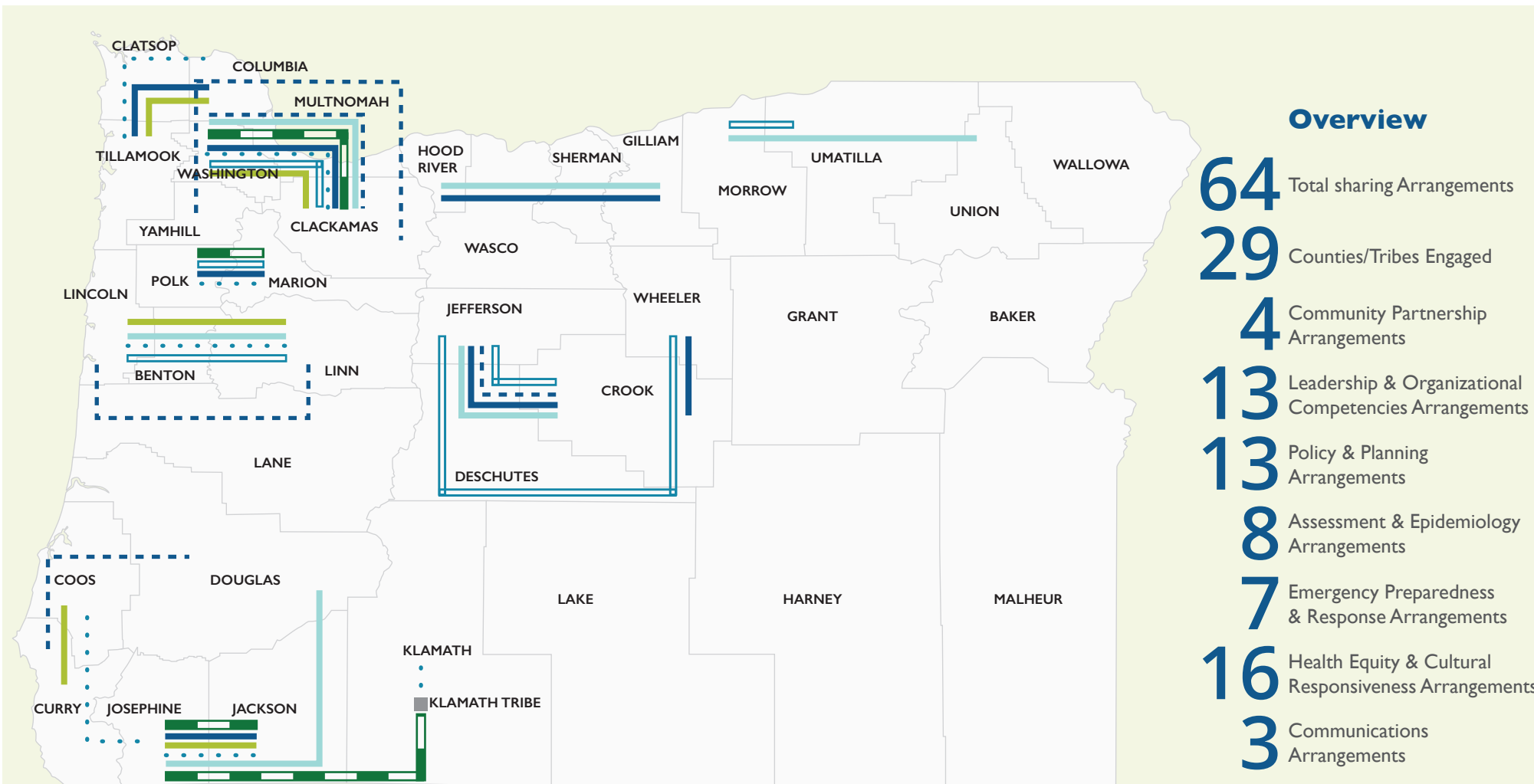

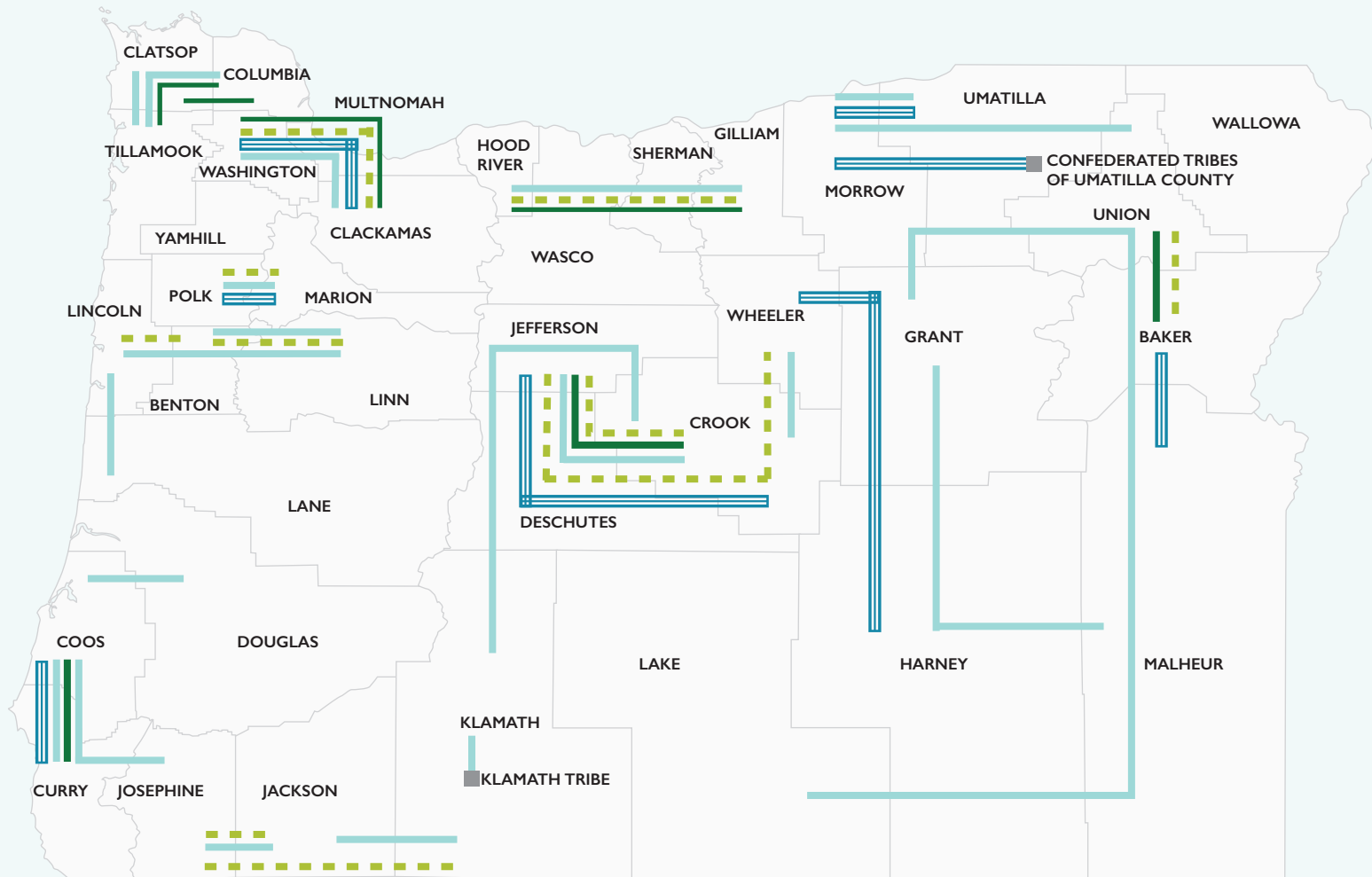
Description:
